Anesthesia / Surgery Consent form

There is always a very small risk that a patient may die under anestheisa. This risk increases in older patients and in patients that have less than perfect organ function. We can help reduce this risk by doing blood tests to look for any underlying disease and by using I.V. fluids to help maintain blood pressure. It is unlikely that a healthy young animal (less than two years old) undergoing a routine spay or neuter should need bloodwork or I.V. fluids.
